The first meeting of 2025 took place on Thursday 23 January 2025. There were 4 members of the public present.

Pavilion



Braintree District Council is reviewing its Local Plan, a key planning document that is used to shape, plan and manage future growth and development across the district.


The Issues & Options stage looks at existing objectives and policies to determine how effective they continue to be and asks you if they need updating.

Amanda Anderson will lead us through a practice of yoga and mindfulness. Guests welcome.


